As a school we will...

- Develop your child as a successful learner, caring citizen, healthy thinker, confident individual, knowledgeable participant and curious explorer.
- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum where your child will acquire knowledge and skills across all the primary subjects.
- Provide a secure, happy and stimulating learning environment where Christian faith leads our way.

- Provide formal and informal opportunities for parents to discuss the work and progress of their child/children.
- Set regular and appropriate home learning for your child.
- Respond promptly to any concerns and treat everyone with courtesy and respect.
- Keep parents informed through newsletters, notices, e-mails, reports and the school website.
- Allow children safe and secure use of the internet through a combination of site filtering, supervision and by fostering a responsible attitude in all pupils.

As a pupil you are expected to:

- Try my best to learn in all lessons.
- Complete my home learning tasks and catch up with any work that I miss.
- Ensure I follow the School Rules both in school, and at break and lunchtimes.
- Be caring, respectful and helpful towards others.
- Be on time for school.
- Wear the proper school uniform.
- Be ready for learning by making sure I have any books, equipment and PE kit with me in school.
- Take good care of school books and property.
- Keep myself safe by following the school's rules on online safety.
- Let my teacher or another adult in school know if I have got any worries or problems.

As a parent or carer you are expected to:

- Ensure that my child attends school punctually every day during term time, unless there is a good reason for absence.
- Notify the school by telephone at the start of the day if my child is going to be absent.
- Ensure that my child wears proper school uniform and has their PE kit when required in school.
- Attend parent/teacher meetings to discuss my child's progress.
- Talk to the class teacher about any concerns related to my child.
- Support my child by reading with them regularly, helping them to complete home learning and signing their reading record diary.
- Ensure that any concerns are dealt with in a respectful manner through face to face contact rather than using public forums, chat rooms or social media.
- Support school in the teaching of safe and secure internet use at home.
